Page County Courthouse

Erected in 1885, this native red brick building occupies the center of town on the original 1852 town plat as the "public block". The courthouse was damaged extensively by a 1991 fire and has been restored to its original beauty, including the clock tower. The courthouse is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday-Friday for business or tours.




Glenn Miller Birthplace Home & Museum


Clarinda Academy
