Page County Courthouse

Erected in 1885, this native red brick building occupies the center of town on the original 1853 town plat as the "public block". The courthouse was damaged extensively by a 1991 fire and has been restored to its original beauty, including the clock tower.

Clarinda Community Trail

Hawley's Opera House Mural

The mural was painted by artist, Kelly Poling, featuring the former Hawley's Opera House that used to be located in the building. The mural has created a beautiful focal point for the downtown area in preserving Clarinda's historical culture.

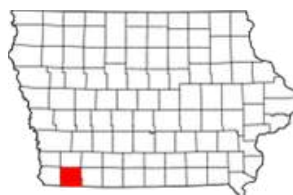
H&H Trailers by Novae
