GLENN MILLER FESTIVAL - CELEBRATING 50 YEARS

The Glenn Miller Birthplace Society is thrilled to announce our 50th Glenn Miller Festival. We have a jam-packed weekend full of music, food, fellowship and fun.

The festival kicks off on Thursday, June 12th with the GMBS Music Scholarship Competition, the Kick-Off picnic, which is a BBQ provided by Fareway, a Japanese "BONTEN" & Mirai "Taiko" drum celebration, courtesy of Mr. Hideomi Aoki, and followed by songs with Nick Hilscher, followed by an evening with Nick, Jarrod, and special guests.

Friday, June 13, brings the Stage Show featuring the GMBS Big Band along with the Music Scholarship Competition winners. Bill Baker's Big Band (from the Netherlands) takes the stage at 10:30 am. Lunch will be catered by Garrison House, followed by Steve Shininger & the ShinSings. Adam Swanson (Ragtime piano player) performs at 3:00 p.m., followed by the World-Famous Glenn Miller Orchestra.

Saturday, June 14, starts with the Festival Pancake Breakfast at the Clarinda Fire Station, featuring the Northwest Missouri State Jazz Group led by Dr. Bill Richardson. The festival entertainment moves back to the Clarinda High School with the festival GMC Dennis Spragg's presentation. Lunch is catered by Tru Bru. You will enjoy "Gooch" and the Guys Big Band at 1:00 pm. The special Glenn Miller Orchestra (featuring the 1937 Miller band) is at 3:00 pm. Bill Baker's Big Band is back at 4:30 pm. The festival dinner, catered by Garrison House, starts at 6:15 pm, and Saturday ends with the Glenn Miller Orchestra in the gym for the dance concert, which includes a swing dance competition.

The Glenn Miller Birthplace & Museum is open all weekend from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.





CITY-WIDE CLEAN UP DAYS

The City of Clarinda has officially announced the City-Wide Cleanup Days for Thursday, May 29 (7:00 a.m.-3:30 p.m.), Friday, May 30 (7:00 a.m.-3:30 p.m.), and Saturday, May 31 (7:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.). Clarinda residents will be able to dispose of the following items, including furniture, appliances, and other electronic equipment. However, the collection site will not accept such items as yard waste, fluorescent lights, household batteries, oil, paint, cleaning chemicals, tires, and pesticides or herbicides. Commercial haulers, contractors, and trailers longer than eight feet are prohibited from using the site.




CLARINDA FIREWORKS DISPLAY CAMPAIGN
