NSK CORPORATION

NSK was established in Japan in 1916 and opened a manufacturing plant in Clarinda, Iowa in 1975, with production of Normal-Sized Roller

Bearings (NSR). In 1987, the NSK-AKS Ball plant was established in Clarinda, Iowa, where it manufactured steel precision balls until 2025.

In 2005, NSK began producing Medium-Sized Roller Bearings (MSR), Magnetic Clutch Bearings (MCB), and Integrated Shaft Bearings (ISB). In 2020, the MCB production was transferred to

an alternative NSK plant. In 2024, ISB production was replaced with a new large Spherical Roller Bearing (SRB) division serving the industrial markets.

NSK has been a long-standing employer in the Clarinda area, providing numerous opportunities for residents in the surrounding areas.

NSK is marking an incredible milestone—50 years of innovation and production right here in Clarinda! To celebrate, NSK Corporation is opening its doors for tours from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Thursday, November 20, as part of the Hometown Holiday Open House. Don't miss this unique opportunity to explore the facility, learn about its legacy in our community, and see firsthand how world-class manufacturing happens in Clarinda.

CLARINDA FLOWERSHOP



and Saturdays, December 6, 13, and 20, from 10-11:30 a.m.





2025 BOND REFERENDUM

No Tax Levy Rate Increase



OVERVIEW

On November 4, 2025, voters will consider a \$55 million bond referendum, to expand and modernize its Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs at Iowa Western Community College. This proposal is designed to strengthen southwest Iowa's workforce—particularly in high-demand fields such as construction, electrical, plumbing, HVAC, welding, diesel technology, automotive technology and logistics. Importantly, it will replace expiring bonds and not increase the current property tax levy rate.

MEETING WORKFORCE DEMAND

Southwest Iowa faces a growing shortage of skilled tradespeople. Iowa Western has the successful CTE programs to address these needs, but is limited by courses that are at or near full capacity. Enrollment in Diesel Technology has surged 234% over the past five years, while Automotive Technology has grown by 180%. These programs are now operating at their limits, leaving qualified students unable to enroll.

The bond will fund:

- A new 86,000-square-foot Transportation and Logistics building in Council Bluffs, doubling capacity for automotive, diesel and CDL training.
- Renovations of existing space to expand other career and technical programs and increase enrollment capacity by 40-50% for welding, plumbing, HVAC, construction and electrical.

The bond will also fund improvements at Iowa Western centers in Atlantic, Clarinda, and Shenandoah. Ensuring students have access to modern training facilities and preparing students to fill critical roles in rural communities, where technicians and other skilled workers are in high demand.

Opportunities for High School Students

More than 600 students currently earn college credit through dual enrollment in Iowa Western's CTE programs. Expanded and renovated spaces will allow even more high school students to:

- Gain early exposure to technical careers
- Earn college credits and reduce future tuition costs
- Enter the workforce sooner, helping meet southwest Iowa's economic needs.

Fiscal Responsibility

- *No tax levy rate increase:* The bond simply replaces expiring bonds.
- *Strategic investment:* The upgrades will serve both students and local employers for decades.
- *Community benefit:* A stronger workforce helps sustain economic growth across southwest Iowa.

This bond referendum is a smart, community-driven solution to strengthen education, support local businesses and prepare students for success in high-demand fields-without raising property tax levy rates.




